## GET AS MANY SPONSORS AS YOU CAN - All the money raised goes to your charity

You can fill as many sponsor forms as you want. The money goes to your own designated charity, which you collect and pay to them directly. Rotary will sign your forms to certify that you have passed our checkpoints.

### Gift Aid: If you sponsor a recognised charitable cause:

By ticking the Gift Aid box, every pound you sponsor or donate can be worth £1.25 to your charity. It doesn't cost you a penny more. By ticking the box headed 'giftaid it' you are agreeing to the following statement - "I want the charity named on this form to reclaim tax on my donation detailed above, given on the date shown. I confirm I am a UK taxpayer and understand that if I pay less Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax in the current tax year than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all my donations it is my responsibility to pay any difference".

To claim Gift Aid you need to complete your **full name, home address, postcode** and a tick in the box. The charity named on this form will only use your details to claim Gift Aid and not for marketing purposes. If you are under 18 you should check with your parent or guardian that it is OK to provide these details.
