## Why Sponsor Us?

Rotary's Got Talent is sponsored by Rotary Club of Maidenhead Bridge. Since 2015, the Rotary Club of Maidenhead Bridge has worked in partnership with Kopundol Rotary Club in Kathmandu and Faringdon Rotary Club in the UK to support the reconstruction of Saurpani Primary School which was devastated during the earthquake.

Saurpani Primary School is close to Barpak, the epicentre of the earthquake. The school serves 8 local villages and has 160 children who walk up to one hour each day to get to the school. There are 8 teachers at the school. Most of the buildings, including schools, in the region were badly damaged by the earthquake. Buildings, on average, suffered 80% destruction.

Maidenhead Bridge Rotary Club, in partnership with other UK Rotary clubs has already help fund the reconstruction of a three classroom teaching block to earthquake resilient standards based on the Nepali Government design criteria. Building upon this success, the proceeds of Rotary's Got Talent will help Rotary reach a target of **£12.5k** required to improve educational and sanitation facilities at the school.



The project has the following principle aims:
